

Ladies Long Range Championship

One Day Open Championship
Open to NRANZ affiliated members and Kindred Organisations

Saturday 7 December 2024

commencing 0900 hrs, CRO briefing at 0845 hrs at the 800yd line.

Details:

- ❖ 2 sighting shots and 10 counting shots at each of 800yds, 900yds and 1000yds.
- ❖ Shot **Bisley Style** using pairs.
- ❖ Sighting shots will be convertible.
- ❖ NRANZ shooting Rules will apply.

Squading, Entry and Fees:

- 🚩 Squading will be computer generated once entries close at 0830hrs on the day.
- 🚩 Competitors will be paired within classes and squaded 3 shooting pairs per target.
- 🚩 Early entry is encouraged via email andre155vld2900@gmail.com
- 🚩 Early payment is encouraged via internet banking to NRANZ account BNZ, Upper Hutt

- 🚩 Please use your name and initial in the banking details . Or cash payment at the sign-in point outside Petone Club Rooms prior to 0815 hrs on the day. The entry fee is \$40 per entry.

Targets:

- ❖ Targets will be electronic ShotMarkers.
- ❖ Competitors to provide their own network viewing device.

Order of Competition:

- ❖ Each Target Lane will consist of no more than three (3) shooting **pairs** competing as three separate shooting relays, controlled by the CRO.
- ❖ Each pair is to decide left or right mound firing position at the start of the 1st match and are to rotate for each of the subsequent matches.
- ❖ The competitor on the right, within the lane, will fire first.
- ❖ 2nd and 3rd relays are to follow CRO instructions regarding moving forward and set up etc.
- ❖ **Nobody** is to move forward onto the mound until instructed to do so, this includes between details.

Time Limit:

- ❖ The time limit for each shot fired will be 60 seconds. Penalties will apply for shots fired over time and shots fired out of turn.
 - T11.3 Firing out of turn, 1 point deduction
 - T13.28 Taking too long, get 1 warning then lose 2 points

Official Scoring:

- ❖ Competitors' scores will be captured electronically by the ShotMarker target system.
- ❖ Score cards will be issued to competitors and used as backup.
- ❖ Competitors will be required to exchange score cards and to act as official register keepers within pairs.
- ❖ Competitors are reminded to bring a small clip board for scoring.

Moving Up Targets:

- ❖ Each squad of three pairs will move up ? number of targets at each distance.
- ❖ The shooting order will remain the same for the day.

Check Scoring:

- ❖ For each match the 3rd relay will act as check scorers on the chalk boards.
- ❖ Relays will rotate the check scoring until the shooting distance is completed.
- ❖ This process will be duplicated at each range for the remainder of the day.

Blow-Off Shots:

- ❖ A manual target will be made available prior to the start of the first match for competitors to use for blow-off shots.
- ❖ Please follow the instructions of the CRO.

Lunch:

- ❖ Lunch will follow the completion of the 900 yd range.
- ❖ No catering will be provided at the shooting venue.

Prizegiving:

- ❖ The official prizegiving will take place outside of the Petone Club Rooms and will follow shortly after the completion of the final match.
